Rev. A. H. "Brother Sam" Sampley, 88, of Englewood, went home to be with the Lord on Tuesday, May 30, 2017. He honorably served his country in the US Army during the Korean Conflict. Brother Sam retired as Pastor at First Baptist Church West Jefferson; however, he continued to serve God at numerous other churches in the area. Many lives were blessed through him organizing the Ohio Southern Baptist Disaster Relief Chaplaincy Ministry and continuing to minister to others in need for 17 years in this outreach. He was preceded in death by his parents, Aaron and Ruth. My beloved, All American Pastor, Brother Sam was called home and entered into the presence of his and our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ. These tears that I cry are for our loss in this earthly life. Sam and Betty ministered to my husband and I, our daughter and my parents, as we were part of the Beaver Creek Baptist Church family during their Divinely appointed time of leadership there. Sam and Betty were an incredible, amazing, Divinely Powered Team. They challenged us to serve, honor and worship in the most powerful way, as they led us by their examples. The truth is that they got us "Fired up for The Lord". I describe their leadership roles by saying that it was God Powered, Christ Powered Faithfulness in action. I can't tell you how many times that he stopped by our office (our family business was right near his church at that time) this was before and after my father's death. He had a true Christian care and concern for us and he showed it. He allowed himself to be an instrument of God, as the hands and the feet of Jesus Christ. As we were so richly blessed by the life of Sam and the ministries of he and Betty, we are continuing the charge to do the same, to faithfully serve with the love of Christ. My prayers have been lifted up and

they will continue to be lifted up...for Betty and for every family member. I know that God will comfort you as only He can do. It is His Promise in His Word ..and.. He will do it. I gave thanks and I will continue to give thanks for the gift from God, that of Brother Sam's part in our spiritual journey here in this life.
