Idabel Mae Hartman, age 95, of Centerville, Ohio went home to be with the Lord on Sunday, March 17, 2019. She was born in Glenmora, Louisiana to Mr. and Mrs. John Winegeart on July 1, 1923. Idabel graduated from Glenmora High School, class of 1940, and Vincent Business College, Lake Charles, Louisiana. Idabel married the love of her life and was whisked away to Ohio by Rowe Hartman on August 3, 1945, to whom she was married for 62 years until his death in 2008. She worked in downtown Dayton for 11 years as a finance officer and then served as church secretary for 20 years at Westwood/Far Hills Baptist Church.
