Mary Alice Eisenhauer, 91, passed away on March 16, 2016 in Oak Ridge, TN. She was born in Dayton on July 17, 1924 to the late Norman J. & Alice Ashton Ritzert. Mary Alice graduated from Julienne High School in 1942. She resided in the Dayton area most of her life.
